## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOR GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Based on Merritt College 2003-2005 Catalog and  
Holy Names University 2002-2004 Catalog

Holy Names University accepts coursework passed with a grade of C- or higher, to a total of 70 community college units. Generally, community college courses are transferred according to California State University guidelines. Remedial and vocational courses are non-transferable. Each course can be used to meet only one general education requirement.

Students who are certified as having completed the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) prior to transfer are not required to take additional lower-division general education coursework. These students would need only to take 2 upper-division ISAC courses plus the Senior Colloquium (see page 2).

As course listings change more frequently than formal articulation agreements, other transfer classes will be evaluated individually during a student's admission process.
