ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOR GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

**Based on Foothill College 2008-2009 Catalog and
Holy Names University 2009-2011 Catalog**

Holy Names University accepts coursework passed with a grade of C- or higher, to a total of 70 community college units. Generally, community college courses are transferred according to California State University guidelines. Remedial and vocational courses are non-transferable. Each course can be used to meet only one general education requirement.

Students who are certified as having completed the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) prior to transfer are not required to take additional lower-division general education coursework. These students would only take 2 upper-division ISAC courses plus the Senior Colloquium (see page 2).

****Foothill is on the quarter system. All quarter units are converted to semester on this articulation agreement.**
