## DEGREE AUDIT HELPFUL HINTS

- The **Total Credits Taken** is the correct unit amount. Mickey Mouse has 102 units making him a Senior.
- The **Total Credits Towards Degree** includes only those units that fulfill a requirement, so at this time, classes listed under **Additional Courses** are not being included in the year calculation. Even though Mickey Mouse has 102 units and is a Senior, he is currently being categorized in Hawk's Edge as a Sophomore (the year is pulled from the 56 units towards degree). Please refer to the **Total Credits Taken** when determining a student's year and total credits.
- The **Total Credits Towards Degree** also double counts Degree, Major, Minor and Concentration requirements. So, you may see a student that has a larger **Total Credits Towards Degree** amount than the **Total Credits Taken**. For example, PHIL 140W may fulfill a GE requirement, an upper division requirement, a writing requirement, and requirement in the major increasing the **Total Credits Towards Degree** to 12, but leaving the **Total Credits Taken** at the correct amount of 3.
- Advisors will need to submit the **Substitution/Exemption Form** when a transfer course fulfills a major requirement. The Registrar's Office will post GE transfer equivalencies, but it is the advisor's responsibility to submit the major requirement substitution paperwork.
- Advisors will need to submit the **ISAC Exemption Form** when an advisee has successfully completed the appropriate number of ISAC classes (for the BA, BS and ABD Degrees only).
- To print the Degree Audit page in FAWeb open the Student Record, scroll over Degree Audits, click on View Details, right click and select Print.
