

Criteria for selection of  
Saint Catherine Medal recipient  
on Kappa Gamma Pi affiliated  
college and university campuses

1. Recipient may be an undergraduate, graduate or non-traditional student (multiple medals may be awarded, one on each level). At universities where different academic divisions exist (e.g. College of Fine Arts, College of Science and Engineering, College of Nursing), one medal may be awarded in each division.
2. Recipient may be a woman or man, a member of a religious community or a member of any religious denomination.
3. Recipient must represent the high ideals of a Catholic college education.
4. Recipient is determined by the college faculty or administration or by student vote; each Kappa college or university establishes its own selection process.
5. Recipient is selected based on her/his leadership and service to the college or university.
6. Kappa Gamma Pi membership qualifications (specifically, an honors GPA) are NOT requirements for this award. Recipients of the Saint Catherine Medal do not necessarily go on to become members of Kappa Gamma Pi upon graduation.
