

Holy Names University Early Admit Contract

In completing the following application and signing it, the student is accepting the Holy Names University offer of admission through the Early Admit Program under the terms described herein.

Holy Names University agrees to honor this admission to the University provided the outlined requirements are met. The University also offers financial assistance as described, and with, the provisions below. This contract does not obligate the student to enroll at Holy Names University and this offer of admission and financial assistance is valid only at Holy Names University and is non-transferrable. This program does not guarantee HNU on-campus housing.

The student understands that his/her admission to HNU and consideration for financial assistance, after completion of high school, are based on the following criteria:

1. The student must complete the minimum UC approved A-G curriculum with the following number of A-G approved courses:

English – 4 years

Math - 3 years

Social Science/History including U.S. History- 2 years

Laboratory Science – 2 years

Language other than English - 2 years of same language or receipt of Seal of Biliteracy (3 years of same language will satisfy the HNU degree requirement)

Visual or Performing Arts – 1 year

College Preparatory Elective - 1 year

- 2. All coursework must be completed with a grade of C- or better and with a cumulative GPA of 2.7 in these courses at the time of graduation.
- 3. Meet with a **College Access Mentor** a minimum of once a semester to discuss academic progress and college preparedness. Students who fall behind satisfactory progress towards completion will be given guidance on corrective actions.
- 4. Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) prior to March 2 of your senior year of high school.
- 5. Notify Holy Names University by **April 1** of your senior year of high school of your intention to enroll in order to be guaranteed a space in the freshman class.
- 6. Students pursuing guaranteed admission to the HNU/SMU 2+2 Nursing Program must complete all Math and Sciences courses with a grade of B- or better and must submit their application to the HNU/SMU 2+2 Nursing program by February 1 of their senior year of high school. This program does not guarantee admission into the nursing program.

Students who meet the minimum requirements for the program listed above are guaranteed a minimum scholarship in the amount of \$9,000 to attend Holy Names University. Students who exceed the minimum GPA criteria may qualify for additional academic scholarship money. Those students who demonstrate significant financial need may also qualify for additional tuition assistance grant money. All merit and need based financial assistance awarded through this program is non-transferrable and only awarded to students who elect to enroll at Holy Names University. The financial assistance awarded is valid only for discount of HNU tuition and is not a cash award. Students must be enrolled at HNU each semester to be awarded the assistance.



Please complete the attached application truthfully and accurately. This application will serve as your application to Holy Names University. You will not need to submit any additional application to HNU. Additional application materials such as an essay, letters of recommendation or SAT or ACT scores will only be requested should they be necessary to strengthen your application for admission should you fail to meet the minimum criteria defined above. At the time of enrollment, you may be asked to submit an essay in preparation for the HNU First Year Experience Program.
